



Album Cover





The lyrics and melodies of the band OK GO's album 'Hungry Ghosts' caused me think of flying through space on some indeterminate journey toward something wonderful. So, the image of a figure flying toward a wormhole was experimented with in many different forms, but this is the one that was landed on. The pink geometric typography is based on sort of the poppy rhythms of OK GO.

Beer Label






